Staying Well After a Behavioral Health Hospitalization

Make sure to schedule a follow-up visit right away

MHS is here to help you and your child stay well after coming home from the hospital. After a hospital stay, it's important to have follow-up care with behavioral health providers.

You or your child should have a follow-up appointment with a behavioral health provider within seven days of being discharged from the hospital. If an appointment was not made by the hospital, call the provider directly to schedule this important appointment. You can also call MHS if you would like help making an appointment.
