

# No high school diploma holding you back?

Learn how MHS can help!

Nearly 10% of Indiana's adults ages 25-64 don't have their high school diploma. Workers who have a diploma earn over \$8,000 more per year than those who don't.

MHS and the Department of Workforce Development (DWD) want to make it easier for HIP members to get their High School Equivalency (HSE) diploma.

# What is HSE?

The HSE is a way for adults to earn a high school diploma. Your HSE diploma can be earned after completing a test based on five subject areas including Math, Reading, Writing, Science, and Social Studies.

### Why should I take the HSE test?

Whether your goal is to get a better job or continue your education to get a certificate, 2-year associate degree or 4-year bachelor's degree, earning your HSE diploma is the first step.

# Does HSE count towards my Gateway to Work hours?

Yes! The time you spend in free Adult Basic Education classes to prepare for the test and time spent taking the test count toward your qualifying hours.

# How can MHS help me get my HSE diploma?

MHS has partnered with DWD to provide HIP members with free vouchers to cover the cost of the Indiana HSE test. When your test is scheduled, MHS can also help you with transportation to and from the testing site through Lyft.

### I want to get my HSE diploma! What do I need to do?
